What is the big skiing/snowboarding news in the area this year? It is the new Bear Creek. Back in March at the end of last season, all of the buildings except the rental shop were torn down. Since then they have been replaced with a brand new facility that is almost too nice to be a ski lodge. They have a lodge, ski/snowboard school and Ski Patrol space. In addition, they have banquet rooms and a 53 room hotel with an indoor pool and hot tubs (inside and outside). There are two new ponds and half of the parking lot has been paved. This has meant a major investment of millions of dollars. They plan to have the restaurant, bar and hotel open year round. Already they are booked for many weddings in the off-season of 2005.

If you have been skiing for a while, maybe you would like to consider our Race Lessons. Since there is more to racing than just going fast, this program will focus on the fundamentals. Or maybe you would like to try snowboarding. Lessons are free with a registration fee of \$15 to help defray the cost of the program. That deal you cannot find anywhere else on earth!

Be sure to have your current FDSC membership card available at the ski area ticket window.

Please buy ahead of time to be ready for any last minute ski plans since most unused vouchers may be returned at the end of the season. **Please note, ALL unused vouchers MUST BE RETURNED to the salesperson you purchased them from, with a self-addressed stamped return envelope, BY THURSDAY, MARCH 18, 2005. NO EXCEPTIONS! Cash will not be accepted. Please make checks to "FDSC" only.**

Jack Frost/Big Boulder have youth vouchers for children, teenagers, and young adults, ages 6-21. This is a great opportunity for family members to take their kids along at a reduced price. There is no weekend upgrade for this voucher!

GROUP A

LEVEL 1 Never skied before

LEVEL 2 - Walk, slide, sidestep, wedge glide and stop. Basic wedge turn (minimal)

GROUP B

LEVEL 3 - Link solid wedge turns on easy green terrain.

LEVEL 4 - Ski all green terrain confidently in wedge turns or beginning wedge-christie (starts turn in wedge, finishes with skis parallel).

GROUP C

LEVEL 5 - Ski wedge-christie turns on easy blue.

LEVEL 6 - Ski beginning parallel turns on green, early-match wedge-christie on blue.

GROUP D

LEVEL 7 - Ski comfortable open parallel on all blue and easy black.

LEVEL 8 - Ski short- and long-radius dynamic parallel on green, blue, and easier black. Skis open parallel on hard black and double black. Skis fall line in blue bumps and easy black bumps with few stops.

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT (Please Read Carefully)

In addition, and to the fullest extent allowed by law, I agree that I will not institute any law suit or other legal action against the Club, its members, officers, directors, delegates, instructors, agents, employees, representatives, servants or assigns as the result of my participation or injury at any Club related activity. Nor will I voluntarily assist anyone else in the pursuit of any such law suit or other legal action.
