We have a Teacher's Trip to welcome in the New Year! There are 3 Western Trips to some Fabulous Destinations! We'll be joining EPSC in Waterville Valley and hopefully taking home the Race Trophy! We have lots of great weekend Trips heading North.

Trip leaders will be giving a short talk on their trips at August 5th at the Membership Appreciation Picnic/FDSC Meeting. Remember, early sign-ups can be sent in starting August 6th, the following day. You must be a current member in good standing or a new member as of June 1st. Please do not send checks before August 6th. Letters must include signed Trip Application Forms and checks to FDSC for each trip's first deposit. For Flying Trips you must also include a Xerox copy of your Passport or Birth Certificate to get correct spellings! Trip Night will still be Thursday, September 2nd. New Members can sign up that night and join trips. EPSC members will also be eligible to sign up for trips that night.

Please remember on fly trips that certain airlines charge additional for luggage. My wife and I usually use a double ski bag to pack our skis and put our boots in our regular luggage.

You can cut extra expenses this way! Remember to keep in good ski shape by hiking, biking, and swimming with some fellow Dutchmen. See you on the Trails, the Beach, the River, or wherever else we'll be!

### General Rules for FDSC Trips

**Eligibility:** Only current FDSC members may participate on trips. Teenagers may travel with a parent or responsible guardian on week-long trips with approval of the Trip Director and Chairpersons.

**Payment:** Only checks made payable to FDSC will be accepted. NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED AT ANY TIME. Please attach a reservation form per trip with your check. Payments must be made by the due dates or you risk losing your spot. They will be offered to people on the waiting lists!

**Cancellation:** There will be a 10% cancellation fee per person if you cancel your trip prior to the cutoff date. If you find a replacement prior to cutoff date, the penalty charge will instead only be \$10.00 per person. If cancellation is received AFTER the cutoff date, a 10% cancellation fee will be imposed in addition to all nonrefundable fees as specified by the lodges, bus companies, and/or airlines. Check with each trip leader for specific cancellation policies that may apply to the trip they are running.

**Borders:** Each trip participant is responsible for obtaining and producing the appropriate travel documents for international travel to allow their admission into and out of any country, including readmission into the USA. While the FDSC will try to provide information to assist you regarding possible travel limitations, it is your responsibility to research and evaluate the laws of a prospective country on a trip itinerary to determine whether limits to admissibility might affect your entry into a country.

**Disclaimer:** All prices are subject to change without notice. Prices may change based upon airline or transportation company changes in policy. You are also responsible for any extra baggage fees the airline may impose in both directions. Trip leaders will let you know as soon as they are aware of any pricing changes that may occur.

**Other:** Trip chairpersons will provide you with itineraries and any special instructions no later than two weeks prior to departure.


